FAST INSTRUCTIONS

Our 40-Day Corporate Fast begins Wednesday, March 5th, and goes through Sunday, April 13th. We will follow the Daniel's Fast Monday - Saturday with a break on Sunday only. The focus of our Fast is to come together as ONE and pray for people on our FRANC list. A FRANC list is a list of Friends, Relatives, Acquaintances, Neighbors, and Co-workers, in your life who you want to see come to Jesus, grow in Jesus, and go with Jesus.

During our Corporate Fast, we will pray at 6 am on Wednesdays, March 12th, 19th, 26th, & April 2nd & 9th in the Sanctuary of New Beginnings Fellowship Church.

This is "The Year of ONE," let us come together as a church family during this time of prayer and fasting as we humble ourselves before the Lord...if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

WHAT IS FASTING?

In the New Testament in Matthew 4, Jesus' earthly ministry is preceded by 40 days of prayer and fasting. In addition, when Jesus taught on fasting in His Sermon on the Mount found in Matthew 6:16, He didn't say *if* you fast, but *when* you fast. In Matthew 9:15, He doesn't say His followers *might* fast; but *they will*. It's something that He expects of us if we are in relationship with Him. It is the path by which we go deeper in our intimacy with Him.

Biblical fasting should not be considered a method for dieting. In addition to a deeper, more intimate relationship with God, other benefits for biblical fasting and prayer are:

- Fasting and prayer can help us hear from God.
- Fasting and prayer can reveal our hidden sins.
- Fasting and prayer can teach us to pray with right motives.
- Fasting and prayer can build our faith.

During a fast, many people choose to abstain from food. However, food is not the only means of fasting. Christians can choose to abstain from anything that hinders or distracts them from getting into a deeper relationship with God. Remember, the objective of fasting is not only to eliminate things from your daily routine, but also to replace them with prayer so that transformation can take place in your life!

WHAT IS THE DANIEL'S FAST?

The Daniel Fast is a spiritual fast based on two biblical accounts of the Prophet Daniel (Daniel 1:15-16, Daniel 10:2-3). In the first biblical account, Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, underwent a ten-day “fast” to not defile themselves with the King’s choice meats that went against their religious restrictions. Instead, they ate vegetables and drank water. At the end of the ten days, they looked healthier and more fit than the other men who ate from the King’s choice foods. In the second biblical account, the Prophet Daniel underwent 21 days of fasting to receive an interpretation for a vision he received. Daniel refrained from eating meat and drinking wine. As a result, at the conclusion of his 21 days of fasting, he received a message from an angel that explained his vision. In both biblical accounts, Daniel undergoes a fast to hear and remain true to his God. The purpose of the Daniel Fast is not to mimic Daniel, but rather to seek God and grow spiritually. It is a time to draw near to God and as you draw near to Him, He will draw near to you.

FOODS TO EAT ON THE DANIEL FAST

- **All fruit** – fresh, frozen, dried, juiced, or canned.
- **All vegetables** – fresh, frozen, dried, juiced, or canned.
- **All whole grains** – amaranth, barley, brown rice, oats, quinoa, millet, and whole wheat.
- **All nuts & seeds** – almonds, cashews, macadamia nuts, peanuts, pecans, pine nuts, walnuts, pumpkin seeds, sesame seeds, and sunflower seeds; unsweetened almond milk. Nut butters are also included.
- **All legumes** – canned or dried; black beans, black-eyed peas, cannellini beans, garbanzo beans (chickpeas), great northern beans, kidney beans, lentils, pinto beans, and split peas.
- **All quality oils** – avocado, coconut, grapeseed, olive, peanut, sesame, and walnut.
- **Beverages** – distilled water, filtered water, spring water, fresh fruit or vegetable juices.
- **Other** – unsweetened almond milk, coconut milk, rice milk, or soy milk; herbs, spices, salt, pepper, unsweetened coconut flakes, seasonings, Bragg’s Liquid Amino, soy products, and tofu

FOODS TO AVOID ON THE DANIEL FAST

- **All meat & animal products** – bacon, beef, lamb, poultry, and pork.
- **All dairy products** – butter, cheese, cream, milk,
- **All sweeteners** – artificial sweeteners, brown rice syrup, cane juice, molasses, raw sugar, syrups, and sugar.
- **All leavened bread & yeast** – baked goods and Ezekiel bread (if it contains yeast and honey).
- **All refined & processed food** products – artificial flavorings, chemicals, food additives, preservatives, white flour, and white rice.
- **All solid fats** – lard, margarine, and shortening.
- **Beverages** – alcohol, carbonated drinks, coffee,

HOW TO HAVE A MEANINGFUL TIME WITH GOD

Definition – The **Quiet Time** is simply a daily time of personal fellowship with God through the Word and prayer. It is a time we deliberately set aside to meet with Him. The objective is that we might grow in our personal relationship with God, so that we can know Him and become more like Him.

Why is daily fellowship with God so important?

1. We were created to have fellowship with Him. (Gen. 2-3)
2. Jesus Christ dies on the cross so that fellowship could be restored. (Cor. 1:9; I John 1:3-4)
3. The regular quiet time during Jesus' ministry was a source of His strength. (Mark 1:35; Luke 5:16; 22:39-44)
4. Every great man or woman of God throughout history has spent much time alone with God. (Moses, David, Daniel and Paul etc.)
5. We cannot be healthy, growing Christians without daily fellowship with the Lord. (Job 23:12; Matt.4:4; I Peter 2:2; Heb. 5:14; Ps. 119:9)

What happens when we have daily quiet time with God?

1. We give devotion to God.
2. We get direction from God.
3. We gain delight in God.
4. We grow more like God.

What are the results of having a daily quiet time?

Joy: Ps. 16:11, 119:47; Jer. 15:16
Strength: Isa. 40:29-31
Peace: Isa. 26:3, 48:18; Rom. 8:6
Stability: Ps. 16:8-9, 46:1-3, 55:22, 57:7
Success: Josh 1:8
Answered Prayer: John 15:7
Others will notice the difference in our lives (Acts 4:13)

When you come to meet with God, you should have the following:

1. Expectancy
2. Reverence
3. Alertness
4. Willingness to obey

When and how long should your time with God be?

1. The general rule: The best time is when you are at your best.
2. Early morning seems to be the best time. It was Jesus' own practice to rise early to pray and meet with the Father (Mark 1:35). However, you choose what is the best time **for you**.
3. Don't watch the clock.
4. Emphasize quality, not quantity.

Where should I have my daily time with God?

1. A secluded place (if possible)
 - Where you can pray aloud without disturbing others
 - Where you have good lighting and reading
 - Where you are comfortable

Below is an example of a six-point workable plan for a quiet time of any duration. You will need the following items for your planned quiet time:

- A Bible
- A Journal/ Notebook

- 1. Wait on the Lord (relax)*
- 2. Pray briefly for God to give you revelation on His Word.*
- 3. Read a section of the Scripture (read).*
- 4. Meditate and memorize (reflect and remember).*
- 5. Write down what God has shown you (record).*
- 6. Have your time of prayer (request)*

A SAMPLE WAY TO PRAY:

- A**---- Adore and Praise God
- C**---- Confess your sins
- T**---- Thanksgiving (Thank God)
- S**---- Supplication (Petitions and Intercessions)

DAILY PRAYERS AND PROMISES

Day 1: Wednesday, March 5th

Father, we pray for strength and power from the Holy Spirit to sustain us in our commitment to this season of prayer and fasting. We declare by faith and works that 2025 is the Year of ONE. Therefore, we come before You with a heart longing for unity, just as Jesus prayed. Lord, make us one—one in spirit, one in love, and one in purpose—just as You and Your Son are one. May we dwell in You and abide in Your presence, so that the world may see and believe that Jesus is the One You have sent. Remove division, heal wounds, and bind us together in perfect harmony, that we may reflect Your glory and draw others to Your truth.

God's Prayer Promise: "We have this confidence before God and receive from Him anything we ask, because we obey His commands and do what pleases him." (1 John 3:21-22)

Day 2: Thursday, March 6th

Father God, we pray for spiritual cleansing. Please make us an instrument of Your peace. Let us throw off everything that hinders us, and sin that so easily entangles.

God's Prayer Promise: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me." Psalm 51:10-12

Day 3: Friday, March 7th

Father, we fast and pray today for Pastor James Anthony Jackson, Sr.-that You who began a great work in him, will carry it on until the day of Christ. We thank You for blessing New Beginnings Fellowship Church with a pastor who is highly favored by You. God bless him with Your strength and power to remain committed to the vision You have given to him for Your people and glory. We ask that You will help us to stay focused and committed to the plan You have for New Beginnings Fellowship Church. Let Your Will be done in us as pastor and people.

God's Prayer Promise: "Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know." (Jeremiah 33:3)

Day 4: Saturday, March 8th

Our prayer as we fast today, is for our staff, ministers and ministry facilitators. We hold them in highest regard because of their work in this ministry and in Your Name. Please bless and keep them as they endeavor to do kingdom work through their many sacrifices and service. Please God bless them for their faithfulness and continue to give them strength for the journey.

God's Prayer Promise: "Sacrifice offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High. Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me." (Psalm 50:14-15)

Day 5: Sunday, March 9th

Father, we come before You with hearts full of gratitude as we celebrate 21 years of Your faithfulness to our church. You have been our foundation, our guide, and our provider through every season. Thank You for every soul that has been saved, every life that has been transformed, and every blessing that has been poured out through this ministry.

Lord, we acknowledge that it is by Your grace alone that we have come this far. Through challenges and triumphs, You have sustained us. You have strengthened our leaders, empowered our members, and allowed this church to be a light in the community. We give You all the glory!

As we step into this new season, we ask for Your continued presence and guidance. May we remain faithful to Your calling, ever growing in love, unity, and purpose. Let this church continue to be a place where You are worshipped and people are changed.

God's Prayer Promise: "Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind." Psalm 107:21

Day 6: Monday, March 10th

Lord, You desire that none should perish but that all should come to repentance. We declare that salvation is coming to our FRANC list! We trust in Your perfect timing and ask that You use us as vessels to share Your love and truth with them.

God's Prayer Promise: "The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9

Day 7: Tuesday, March 11th

Father, we come before You with humble hearts, lifting up our leaders and all those in positions of authority. Grant them wisdom to govern with integrity, justice, and compassion. May they seek the well-being of all people, setting aside division and working toward unity and peace. Guide their decisions so they may uphold the dignity of every person, protect the vulnerable, and foster a society built on fairness, kindness, and understanding. Remove any spirit of greed, selfish ambition, or discord, and replace it with a heart for service and reconciliation. Lord, help us as citizens to support what is good, to be voices of peace in our communities, and to work together for a future of hope. Let Your love be the foundation of our nation, and may Your peace reign in our land.

God's Prayer Promise: "You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it." (John 14:14)

Day 8: Wednesday, March 12th

We fast with Prayers of Confession. I confess my sins today, Father God. I desire to be holy as you are Holy. Please cleanse me and restore me as I confess my sins. Thank You for being faithful, just, forgiving my sins and purifying me from all unrighteousness.

God's Prayer Promise: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

Day 9: Thursday, March 13th

Father God, we thank You for our awesome First Lady! Lord, please remind Lady Tara-especially on today - that she is loved dearly by her New B Family! We fast and pray that You will bless her for the sacrifices that she consistently makes for us and Your Kingdom. Charm is deceptive, and beauty does not last; but a woman who fears the Lord will be greatly praised. Reward her for all she has done. Let her deeds publicly declare her praise. (Proverbs 31:30-31) Please continue to grant her peace, patience and protection.

God's Prayer Promise: "The man who finds a wife finds a treasure and receives favor from the Lord." (Proverbs 18:22)

Day 10: Friday, March 14th

We fast with Prayers of Worship. My soul magnifies the Lord! I stand in awe of Your greatness and power. I long for Your presence. I glorify Your Name for You have done great things. I worship You!

God's Prayer Promise: "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit - fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name." (John 15:16)

Day 11: Saturday, March 15th

Today we fast and pray with an attitude of gratitude. Father, I thank You for all spiritual gifts, for adopting me as Your own child, forgiving my sins, giving me wisdom, revealing Your will and giving me an inheritance. I thank You for supplying all my needs and for unspeakable joy!

God's Prayer Promise: "Everything is possible for him who believes." (Mark 9:23)

Day 12: Sunday, March 16th

Father, we rest in You today and give you praise, honor and glory. Restore and renew us for this journey of Lent. We pray for unity in the Body of Christ. May New Beginnings Fellowship Church be a church that honors Him.

God's Prayer Promise: "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will He hears us. And if we know that he hears us - whatever we ask; we know that we have what we asked of Him." (1 John 5:14-15).

Day 13: Monday, March 17th

Father, we pray as a church, asking that You will help New Beginnings Fellowship Church be the church You have called for - A House of Prayer. We ask in faith, in the Name of Jesus that You will convict our hearts to pray in the spirit on all occasions, with all kinds of prayers and requests. Father, I exalt You and praise You; I give You glory, honor and praise for You are so awesome! God's Prayer Promise: "Where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them." (Matthew 18:20)

God's Prayer Promise: "Let us approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need." (Hebrews 4:16)

Day 15: Wednesday, March 19th

Father, we fast and pray, seeking Your guidance and blessing for our personal needs. Lord God, we know that Your Word is true; that You will supply all of our needs according to Your riches in glory. Lord, please help us to stand in faith and to seek Your kingdom and Your righteousness so that all we need will be added to us. Thank You in advance for all of Your provisions.

God's Prayer Promise: "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father." (James 1:17)

Day 16: Thursday, March 20th

Father God, we fast and pray today for the ministries of New Beginnings Fellowship Church. Please strengthen ministry department to fulfill the mission and vision of Your church in order to support and provide the enrichment and encouragement needed by our members and the community. Lord, we pray that You will send more workers with a heart like Yours to genuinely receive and effectively serve the harvest that you have ordained by assignment to send to us.

God's Prayer Promise: "Open wide your mouth and I will fill it." (Psalm 81:10a)

Day 17: Friday, March 21st

Father God, today we are fasting and praying for Little Beginnings Nursery and Kingdom Kids Ministry. Lord, help us to fulfill our desire to continue to provide a nurturing environment for all children during our worship services and throughout the week. We pray for Your protection and the safety of our children, workers inside and outside of our facilities by the power of Your Blood. We thank You for those who have made the commitment to serve on this ministry team. We ask that You will convict the hearts of all who have been given the gift of nurturing and helps to minister to our children.

God's Prayer Promise: "We have confidence before God and receive from Him anything we ask, because we obey His commands and do what pleases Him." (1 John 3:21b-22)

Day 18: Saturday, March 22nd

Father God, we fast and pray for the restoration of marriages and families. May each husband love his wife as he loves himself and each wife respect her husband. We ask that you will strengthen husbands and wives so that they will be able to stand against the schemes of the enemy to destroy the unions of marriage you have established.

Day 19: Sunday, March 23rd

Father, we pray today in humility. We ask for Your guidance, power, strength and wisdom so that New Beginnings Fellowship Church will be a church body of love, perseverance and faithfulness in service with the highest level of excellence, integrity and respect. Lord, give them the power to live in this world and not be of it. We pray that they will not be ashamed of the gospel but boldly live it out loud for You!

God's Prayer Promise: "Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it." (Proverbs 22:6)

Day 21: Tuesday, March 25th

We fast and pray for our Multi-Media Ministry. Our desire is to obey the command from Jesus Christ to be the salt in and light to the world through the many means to express the true Gospel to the nations. "He said to them, 'Go to all the world and preach the good news to all creation' (Mark 16:15). Father, we pray that You will bless all who are a part of our Multi-Media Team: Audio, Video, Radio, Visual Presentation and Social Media. Thank you for their gifts, talents, skills, expertise and most of all, their hearts and faithfulness in service.

God's Prayer Promise: "Have faith in God. Whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours." (Mark 11:22, 24)

Day 22: Wednesday, March 26th

We fast with Prayers of Praise. Father, I praise You today. My heart and mind are fixed on the image of Jesus Christ Who is pure, loving, kind, holy, and gentle. My soul says Hallelujah! Father, I exalt You and praise You; I give You glory, honor and praise for You are so awesome!

God's Prayer Promise: "Where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them." (Matthew 18:20)

Day 23: Thursday, March 27th

We fast and intercede today for foreign missions and oppressed people of the world. "The Lord works righteousness and justice for all the oppressed" (Psalm 103:6). Father God, we pray for those who have been called to foreign mission fields and those who minister to oppressed people of this world. Please send provision and give them protection, strength, endurance and supernatural power as they share the gospel to the ends of the earth. "Ask the Lord, the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest field." (Matthew 9:38)

God's Prayer Promise: "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land." (2 Chronicles 7:14)

Day 24: Friday, March 28th

We fast and intercede for the ministry facilitators of New Beginnings Fellowship Church. With thanksgiving, we pray that they will receive strength, power and insight as they persevere and minister to the people of this church and community. We pray for their families, finances, transportation, time management and complete well-being. "Remember your leaders, who spoke the Word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith." (Hebrews 13:7).

God's Prayer Promise: "Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective." (James 5:16)

Day 25: Saturday, March 29th

We fast and intercede for the sick and shut-in. "The Lord will sustain him on his sickbed and restore him from his bed of illness." (Psalm 41:3). We pray for healing and restoration of those who are sick and confined to their homes. Lord, please provide the comfort and peace that only You can give.

God's Prayer Promise: "But he said to me, my grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." (2 Corinthians 12:9a)

Day 26: Sunday, March 30th

We pray today for the unsaved and the unchurched in our communities. Father, help us to bring the Good News of hope and the promise of eternal life to a dying world. As we lift up Your Son, may those who do not know Him desire to be saved by a faith that only comes by hearing the message we bring of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news." (Romans 8:15a)

God's Prayer Promise: "He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him." (Psalm 91:15)

Day 27: Monday, March 31st

Father, we fast and intercede today for bereaved families. Lord, bless and comfort them now and in the days to come. Please, Lord, give them a peace that comes from You only and the comfort of Your Holy Spirit that You promised in Your Word. "But you, O God, see trouble and grief; you consider it to take it in hand." (Psalm 10:14). "My comfort in suffering is this: Your promise preserves my life." (Psalm 119:50). "If your law had not been my delight, I would have perished in my affliction." (Psalm 119:92)

God's Prayer Promise: "We do not have a priest who is unable to sympathize with our weakness, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are - yet was without sin. Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need." (Hebrews 4:15-16)

Day 28: Tuesday, April 1st

Father God, we fast and pray today for unmarried members and single parents. We pray that they will be imitators of God and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us. "No

temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.” (1 Corinthians 10:13)

God’s Prayer Promise: “Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in Heaven give good gifts to those who ask Him!” (Matthew 7:9-11).

Day 29: Wednesday, April 2nd

Father, we fast and pray today for the homeless and orphans. “Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Some wandered in desert wastelands, finding no way to a city where they could settle. They were hungry and thirsty, and their lives ebbed away. Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and He delivered them from their desires. He led them by a straight way to a city where they could settle. Let them give thanks to the Lord for His unfailing love and His wonderful deeds for men. For He satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things.” (Psalm 107:4-9)

God’s Prayer Promise: “If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.” (James 1:5)

Day 30: Thursday, April 3rd

O God, hear our prayer for the healing of illnesses and diseases among us. Jesus, we thank You today for You were pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon You and by Your wounds we are healed. “Praise the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits - who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.” (Psalm 103:2-5)

God’s Prayer Promise: “The Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God’s will.” (Romans 8:26-27)

Day 31: Friday, April 4th

O, Lord, hear our prayer today as we fast for those who are addicted to drugs, alcohol and other strongholds. Father, we not only pray for the restoration of these persons but we also pray for their families. We pray that as they cry out to You that You will hear them and save them from their distress.
